Below is an update regarding COVID-19 vaccine. **21.3%** of North Dakotans have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

- Most of the state is now in Phase 1C <u>essential workers</u> and people at <u>increased</u> <u>risk</u> for COVID-19.
 - 57.2% of North Dakotans are considered an essential worker (according to United Way). Please reach out to businesses in your area and offer vaccination of staff.
 - Essential workers include (examples are not all inclusive):
 - Energy (electric, wind, petroleum, natural gas)
 - Education (childcare, preK-12, university)
 - Communications and Information Technology (cyber security, support, cable, telecom)
 - Water and wastewater
 - Public works and infrastructure support services (plumbing, HVAC, road clearing, waste removal)
 - Transportation and logistics (delivery services, airlines, trains, buses, trucking)
 - Other community or government (federal, state and local employees, clergy, veterinarians)
 - Food and Agriculture (farming, manufacturing, veterinarians, grocery workers, restaurant staff)
 - Financial services (banks, accounting)
 - Hazardous materials (medical waste, cleaning products)
 - Defense Industrial Base
 - Hygiene products and services (laundry, cleaning, pest control)
 - Residential/shelter facilities, housing and real estate, and related services (real estate, animal shelters, construction)
 - Critical manufacturing (parts, equipment, PPE)
 - Chemical (cleaning, transport)
 - Commercial facilities (construction, retail, hotels)
 - Healthcare and public health
 - Law enforcement, public safety, and first responders
 - 50.8% of North Dakotans are at increased risk for COVID-19 (according to BRFSS). Please use electronic medical records, prescriptions, etc. to identify those with one or more underlying health conditions and offer vaccination.
